Glyn Hughes 1931-2014

The **Nicosia Municipal** Arts Centre, associated with the Pierides Foundation and the Cultural Services of the Ministry of Education and Culture cordially invite you to the opening of the exhibition 'Glyn Hughes 1931-2014'. The big retrospective exhibition will be opened by President Nicos Anastasiades on Friday May 27 at 7pm under the auspices of the British High Commission.

Glyn was a Welshman and he was a resident of Cyprus for almost six decades (1956-2014). He acted as a catalyst for the development of contemporary art in Cyprus and not just that. He is regarded as a pioneer of the modernisation of the local cultural scene and had a very close relationship with the High Commission and the British Council. Apart from a huge number of Glyn's paintings, around 50 paintings of British artists - from his collection - will also be exhibited. An opening party will follow in the Powerhouse garden at 8pm.

The venue NiMac is located at 19 Palias Ilektrikis, Old **Nicosia**. The duration of the exhibition will be from May 27 until July 29 and will reopen in September 6 until December 17. Open hours are Tuesday to Saturday 10am-9pm. For more information call 22797400 or visit www.nimac.org.cy
